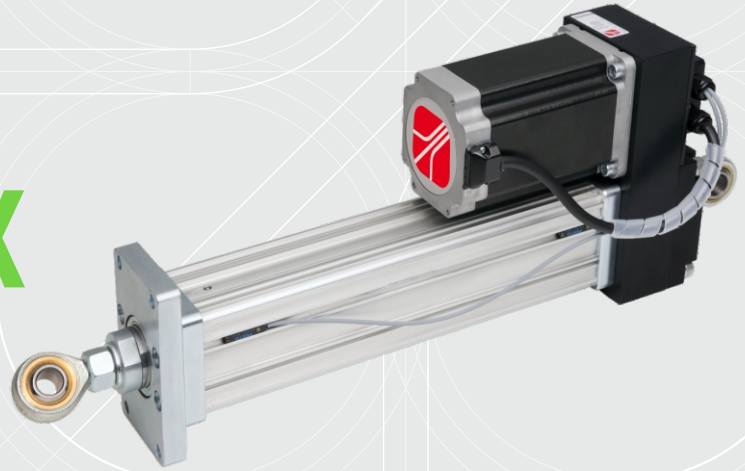




# AT.1203-R SMX

## LINEAR ACTUATOR



- ✓ Installed on unwinding and rewinding stations
- ✓  $\pm 100$  mm stroke
- ✓ Very high thrust force, 10000 N
- ✓ Gear box shifting actuator
- ✓ Fixing with rod ends bearing

Linear actuators are generally used on unwinding and rewinding stations of compact machines to align the reel perfectly.

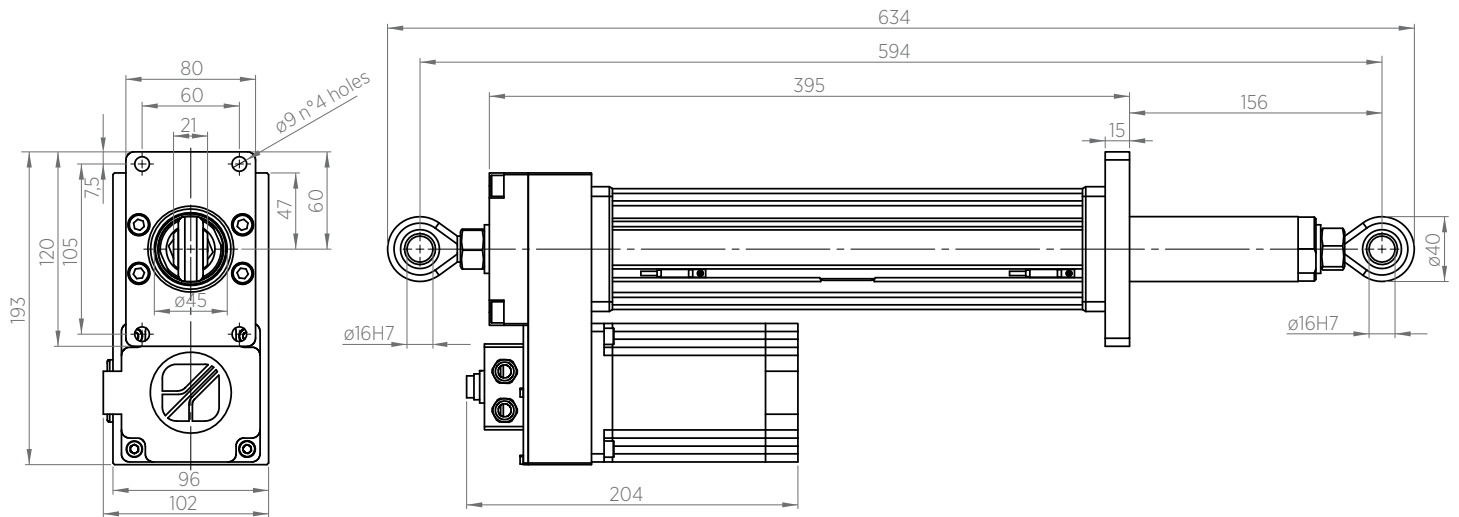
AT.1203-R SMX is usually used on applications that require a very high thrust; the actuator can guarantee a stroke of  $\pm 100$  mm and a max thrust of 10000 N.

The AT.1103-R supermaxi is available in the gear box shifting version with rod ends bearing fixing to guarantee a very high thrust force.

The reed electronic limit switch are inserted in the slots of the stem and are easily accessible in case the operator needs to change the stroke of the actuator.

All parameters and set up of the actuators are easily managed by the operator using the MWG10.1 controller.
